
To Whom It May Concern:

I would like to nominate former Taylor County High School coach Fred Waddle to the Dawahares/KHSAA Hall of Fame. Coach Waddle guided four basketball teams to the Sweet 16 tournament during his 16 years as head coach. He served as cross-country coach for 15 years, and his teams won eight regional titles. Coach Waddle also was assistant basketball coach to Hall of Famer Billy B Smith for 13 seasons, including Taylor County's 1963 trip to the state tournament.

Coach Waddle taught biology for 29 years at Taylor County High School before becoming Taylor County Judge Executive. He later served as principal of Mannsville Elementary and vice principal of Taylor County Elementary schools before retiring in 2006. He has received numerous awards and honors during his career.

In addition to being an outstanding coach, educator, and civic leader, Coach Waddle was an excellent role model for students and athletes. I believe he is very deserving to be in the Dawahares/KHSAA Hall of Fame.
