



Kaye Beard Potter

Kaye Beard Potter enjoyed success on the links early and often, capturing her first tournament title at the age of 12. As a golfer for Campbellsville High School, Beard Potter won her first KHSAA State Individual Championship in 1965 as a ninth-grader. She finished as State Individual runner-up in 1966 and then returned to the top of girls' prep golf as the State Individual Champion in 1967 and 1968. Kaye was also Kentucky Women's State Amateur Champion in 1966, 1969 and 1980 and runner-up in the event in 1968, 1971 and 1973. Beard Potter was selected as the No. 1 junior golfer in the country in 1968 by Golf Magazine. She competed in many National Amateur Tournaments and was runner-up in the United States Golf Association National Tournament in 1968. Beard Potter played collegiate golf at the University of Kentucky, earning All-America honors in 1970.
