

James Brock

"Jack" Brock began his coaching career at William Grant High School in Covington in 1955. In his first season, William Grant recorded a 6-1 record in the Kentucky Negro Basketball Conference and went 18-7 overall. In the 1956-57 season, Grant became a member of the KHSAA and defeated Dixie Heights in the finals of the 34th District Tournament. The school was the first black team to win a district tournament as a member of the KHSAA and finished the year 23-4. In the 1957-58 season, Grant became the first black team to win a regional tournament of the KHSAA. Grant would make four trips to the State Tournament under Coach Brock, including two quarterfinal finishes in 1959 and 1964. Brock compiled a 185-69 career coaching record in 23 seasons.
