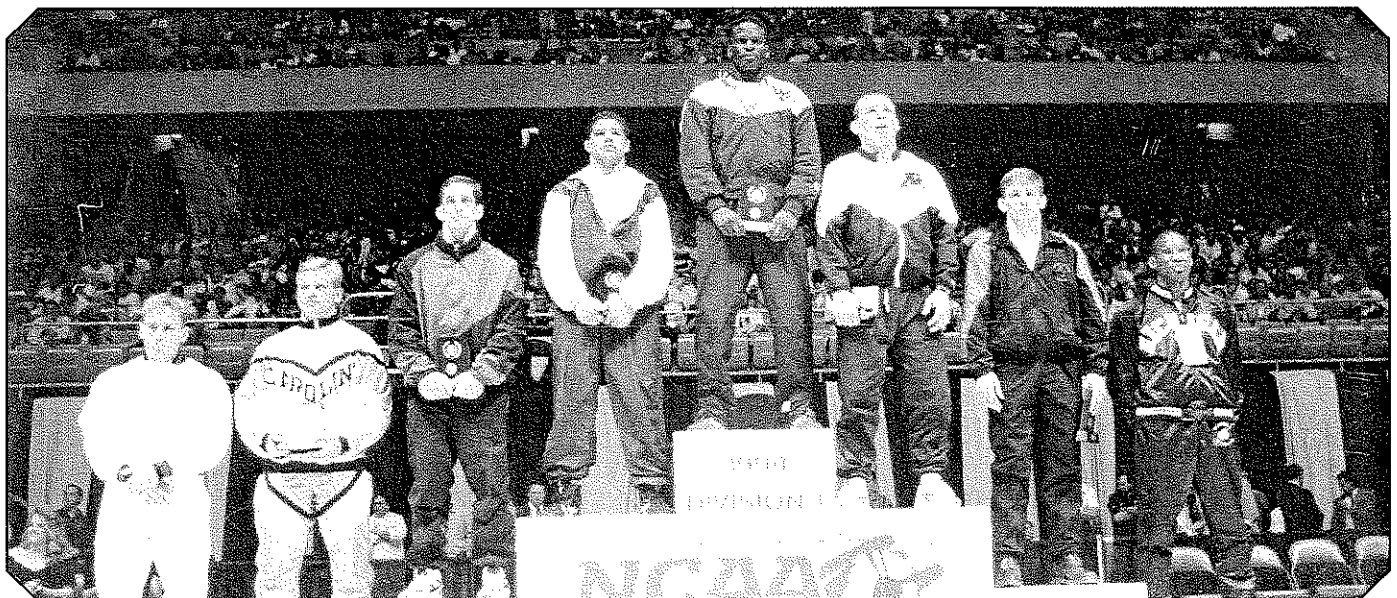

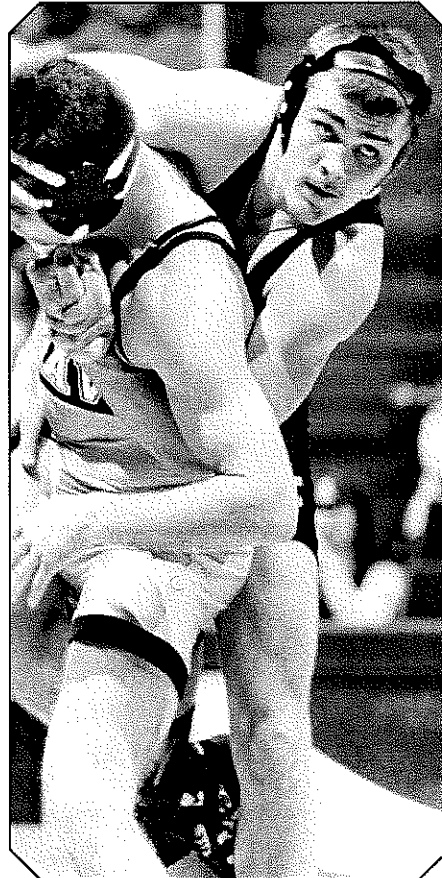

Joseph Reginald Carr was born to wrestle. The son of Joseph and Hilda Carr, Joe followed in the footsteps of his father and his uncles in maintaining the tradition of wrestling in the Carr Family. Joe began wrestling at the age of six.

While in middle school, he never lost a match. While in middle school Joe beat out a varsity high school wrestler and went on to win his first state title. He attended Woodford County High School where he had the opportunity to be coached by his mentor and father. In his freshman year, Joe finished second in the State and followed this accomplishment with three consecutive State titles. Some of Joe's other accomplishments in high school wrestling include five-time district champion, five-time regional champion, three-time Junior National-All American. In addition to placing at the High School Nationals during his senior year Joe was among the top 15 recruits in the nation.

During his senior year, Joe compiled an impressive record of 51-0. Joe is one of the best statistical wrestlers in America and in the State of Kentucky and until 2004 held the national record for most holds high school wins (242-7).

Joe attended West Virginia University where he tied third all times for wins as a freshman in all weight classes. As a sophomore, Joe won the EWL Championship at 157 pounds, was second on the team with 28 wins, and was ranked as high as 14<sup>th</sup> nationally. While wrestling at WVU Joe had over 100 career wins, was a four-time NCAA qualifier, two time Eastern Wrestling League Champion and a three time Eastern Wrestling League Finalist.

Joe is married to his college sweetheart Nicole. He now teaches and is also a co-head coach at Woodford County High School.
