

JIMMIE REED

Jimmie Reed was a two sport star at Bardstown St. Joe Prep from 1965-1968. Reed transferred to Washington Co HS in 1968 after St. Joe Prep closed. He played on the first Washington Co Little League Football Team in 1963. In Reed's first high school football at St. Joe Prep as a freshman he was listed as a 4th string halfback where he entered his first varsity game and scored 3 TD's. He led St. Joe in scoring, yards gained for three straight years and averaged over 7 yards per carry his sophomore and junior year. He was most dangerous when returning punts where he averaged over 15 yards a return his sophomore and junior year. He made all state his junior year and was all conference 3 years in a row. Entering his senior year at Washington Co HS he sustained a knee injury which required surgery and did not play football his senior year. Reed's speed also was seen on the track with his times in the 100 yard dash at 9.9 and he tied the Mason Dixon 70 yard dash record in 1969 with a time of 7.0. Reed won the state championship in 1969 in the 180 yard low hurdles. Reed accepted a football scholarship at the University of Kentucky where he lettered three years 1970-71-72. He made honorable mention All SEC Sophomore Team while being the second leading rusher for the Wildcats. Reed graduated from UK in 1973 and started his career in coaching, teaching, and school administration which lasted 27 years at Washington Co HS. He was the head football coach for 17 years with a record of 113-78 which included 5 district titles, 4 regional runner-up titles and 1 regional title. He coached boys track at Washington Co HS for 19 years. He also served the school as Athletic Director where he was named the Kentucky HS Athletic Director of the Year Finalist in 1999 and was named the Athletic Director of the Year in 2001. He became a Certified Athletic Administrator in 1992. Reed was President of the Kentucky HS Coaches Association in 1987-88 and was elected as the Executive Director of the Kentucky High School Coaches Association along with All Star Game Director for the Kentucky/Tennessee All Star Football Classic in 1988--positions he still holds. He has served as President of the National Federation of Coaches Association in 1995-96; President of the National Organization of Coaches Associations Directors (NOCAD) in 1994-95; still holds the position as State Director for the National Federation of Coaches Association; serves as the Secretary/Treasurer of the Kentucky Football Coaches Association. He was inducted into the Washington Co HS Athletic Hall of Fame in 2001; was inducted into the 5th Region Athletic Directors Hall of Fame 2002; was inducted into the National High School Athletic Coaches Associations Hall of Fame in 2002. Reed retired from education in 2001 after 27 years and is now a regional sales representative for the Balfour Company. He continues being active with all star games during the summer and the Kentucky High School Coaches Association.

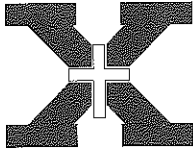

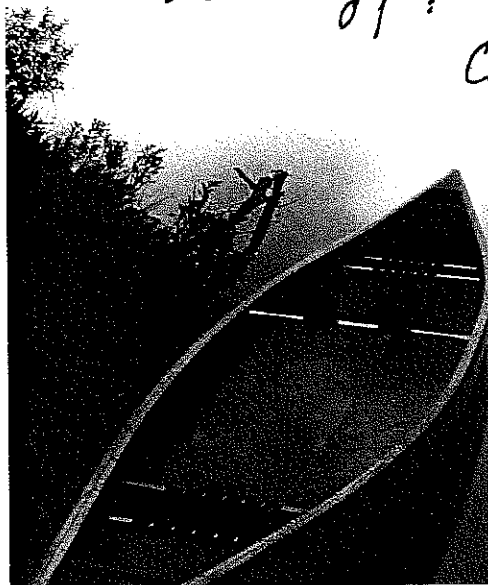
