AS OF 2003

FOR OVER FIFTY-THREE (53) YEARS JOYCE HAS EITHER PLAYED, OFFICIATED THE GAME OF BASKETBALL AND HAS SERVED 31 YEARS AS EITHER THE CO-DIRECTOR OF THE GIRLS LOUISVILLE INVITATIONAL BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT AND BEGINNING THE YEAR OF 1999 AS THE DIRECTOR OF THE TOURNAMENT.

JOYCE IS A GRADUATE (1956-60) OF THE UNIVERSITY OF KENTUCKY . SHE LETTERED IN BASKETBALL, FIELD HOCKEY, VOLLEYBALL AND SOFTBALL. THE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL TEAM FOR FOUR (4) YEARS WAS UNDEFEATED WERE SHE AVERAGED 19 POINT PER GAME AND 11 REBOUNDS. SHE WAS SELECTED THE MOST VALUABLE PLAYER FOR THREE OF HER FOUR YEARS AT THE UNIVERSITY OF KENTUCKY..

JOYCE IS AN OUTSTANDING INDIVIDUAL WHO WAS INSTRUMENTAL IN BRINGING GIRLS BASKETBALL TO BEING A FORERUNNER IN THE STATE OF KENTUCKY. IN (1999) SHE WAS RECOGNIZED BY CONFERENCE USA AND UNIVERSITY OF LOUISVILLE FOR HER OUTSTANDING CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE ACHIEVEMENT OF GIRLS AND WOMEN IN SPORTS.

IN 2002 SHE WAS INDUCTED INTO THE BY THE METRO (LOUISVILLE) AREA ATHLETIC DIRECTORS HALL OF FAME.

JOYCE'S CONTINUAL COMMITMENT AND DEDICATION TO GIRLS & WOMEN'S SPORTS HAS ALWAYS AND CONTINUES TO BE A PURE LOVE & DEDICATION. TO YOUNG GIRLS AND WOMEN IN SPORTS.




