### **Please summarize this person's accomplishments as a coach, player, official or contributor at the high school level in Kentucky.**

Jade Perry - The career leader in scoring (2,792 points), rebounds (1,647), blocked shots (512), and field goal percentage (62.3) at Muhlenberg North, Jade Perry was a three-time First Team All-State selection and three-time 3rd Region Player of the Year. She helped lead the Lady Stars to five-straight Sweet Sixteen appearances from 2000-2004, advancing to the Final Four twice. She ranks fifth all-time in scoring in state tournament history with 183 points and is 10th in rebounding with 90. Additionally, Perry won a track & field state championship in the Shot Put in 2003. Perry signed with the University of Maryland and was a key contributor on the Terrapins' 2006 NCAA National Championship team.

Perry comes from State University of New York at Canton where she was the head women's basketball coach from May 2016 to March 2017. Perry led her team to the most individual accolades in school history at that time. She was an assistant coach at Albright College in Reading, Pennsylvania

A three-time Street & Smith's Honorable Mention All-American ... three-time Third Region Player of the Year, leading Muhlenberg North H.S. to its fifth-straight region title in 2004 ... Louisville Courier-Journal first team all-state honoree four times and tabbed the publication's No. 1 player in the state in a 2003 preseason poll ... 2004 Miss Basketball state finalist and a member of the state all-star team ... also led team to three-consecutive 10th District titles ... Lady Stars posted a 53-13 record over her final two seasons ... finished prep career with 2,792 points, 1,647 rebounds and 512 blocks, all school records ... carried a career .624 shooting percentage, going 1,150-for-1,834 from the floor ... also fifth all-time in state tournament games with 183 points and 10th with 90 career blocks ... lists winning the 2003 state championship in the shot put as biggest thrill.
