Stan was an outstanding Basketball player in high school at Ralph Bunche. He was the all time leading scorer and Record holder until Charlie Hunter broke his record.

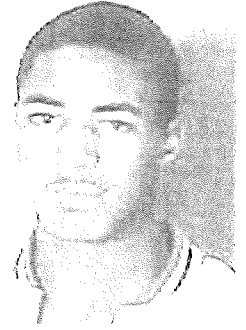

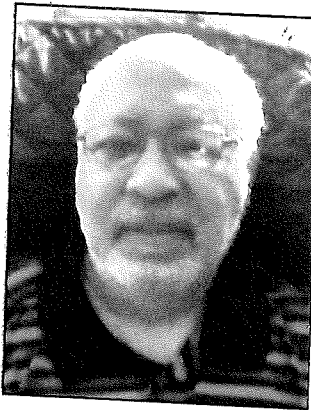

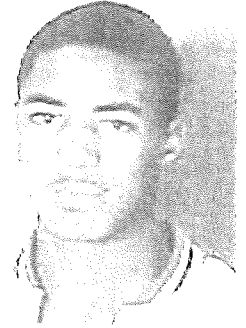
