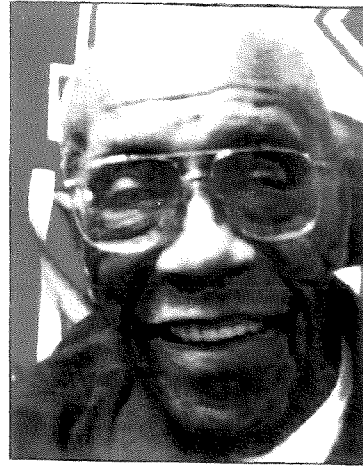

Career Achievements

He was an exceptional football player /Track at State Street High School From 1941- 1945(Graduated)

The best Running-Back in The Kentucky High School Athletic League-East- 41 Region 3. The State Street Mustangs had the best winning Season record, winning The Sectional Play-off and The Regional Play-Off in the mid-1940's. The Mustangs went on to win The State Championship beating The Powerhouse Louisville Central High School

The State Street Mustangs(Coach by-Joe B. Ownby), advanced on to The National Football Tournament and won The High School National Football Championship.

Welmon, was recognized with many High School Honors: he lettered 4 Years in Football, All-State Honors and won a Football Scholarship to North Carolina College for Negroes(now NC Central Univ.) in Durham, North Carolina.

He had a very successful College career and was selected All-Conference. The NC College for Negroes- Eagles, beat the Top Ranked Tennessee State A&I(now TN. State Univ. Tigers) in their Play-off Bowl in Washington, D.C. that gave The Eagles National Ranking among all The Historical Black Colleges in the Nation in the Mid-1940's.
