When Larry Allison started coaching at Millersburg Military Institute in 1972, I would imagine that he had no idea that he would be coaching in some sense of the word for the next 50 years. During this time, Larry was a High School Head Coach or an Assistant Coach for more than 2400 ball games on the sidelines of girls and boys basketball, softball, baseball, tennis and football. Larry, as mentioned before, began his career at MMI, but also coached at Deming (Robertson Co), Harrison Co and Clark Co High Schools. He was the head coach of 6 10th Region Championships ('95 Slow Pitch and Fast Pitch/'02, '03, '07, '11 Baseball) and Assistant Coach for another 5 Region Crowns ('90, '92 Baseball/'07, '11, '12 Boys Basketball). He also was a member of the Bluegrass Umpires Association for nearly 10 years in the 1980's.
