Jerry Taylor served the students of Hart County Schools as a teacher, coach, and athletic director for 57 years. His teaching career began before he graduated college in the 1965-1966 school year at the Carter-Dowling School as the PE teacher. He coached girls varsity basketball from 1983-1986 @ Hart County High School. In 1983 Jerry became the athletic director for Hart County School District, serving a total of 39 years in this role. Jerry retired from teaching in 2000 from Hart County High School. He continued to serve as the district's athletic director until he retired from the position on August 1, 2022. During his time as athletic director he served as tournament manager at the district and regional levels for basketball, baseball, softball, volleyball, and track.

In addition to this, Jerry has been a member of the 5th Region Athletic Directors' Association, and he served on the 5th Region Policy Board as President for 20 years. Jerry also served on the KHSAA Board of Control for 8 years representing the 5th and 6th Regions where he held both the vice-president and president board positions. On December 7th 2024, Hart County High School gym is now known as the Jerry Taylor Gymnasium.
