Gwen Doyle Howard is one of the most accomplished players in Kentucky girls' basketball history. A 1990 graduate of du Pont Manual High School in Louisville, Kentucky, Doyle ended her high school career as the all-time leading scorer in du Pont Manual history with an astonishing 2,997 points. Known for her dominance on both ends of the court, she averaged 32 points and 14 rebounds per game as a senior, earning the prestigious title of Gatorade Player of the Year in Kentucky.

Doyle's senior year was filled with accolades, including selection to the USA Today Super 25 and being honored with the Naismith Award for the top player in Kentucky. A three-time First-Team All-State honoree during her sophomore, junior, and senior seasons, she also led her team with unmatched intensity and consistency.

Her performance in the 1989 game against Wagner High School remains legendary, setting Manual's single-game records with 50 points and 40 rebounds. Over her final two seasons, she led the Lady Crimsons to a combined 69–7 record and was named Most Valuable Player of the Louisville Invitational Tournament in both her junior and senior years.


Doyle was selected to represent Kentucky in the 1990 Kentucky-Indiana All-Star series and is a proud member of the Kentucky All-Stars Hall of Fame and duPont Manual High School Hall of Fame. Manual also retired her number 43 and her banner hangs in the school gymnasium. Following her stellar high school career, she earned a basketball scholarship to the University of Louisville, where she played two seasons before transferring to Western Kentucky University to complete her collegiate career and graduated with her Bachelor of Arts degree in communications in 1995. She later took her talents overseas and played professional basketball in Belgium for two years.

Gwen Doyle Howard's impact on the court and her contributions to Kentucky basketball history remain remarkable. Her legacy continues to inspire generations of athletes across the Commonwealth.


