Please summarize this person's accomplishments as a coach, player, official or contributor at the high school level in Kentucky.

Coach Jeff Lendon of Mt. Sterling, KY is a pioneer in Kentucky high school soccer. A Michigan native and graduate of Morehead State University, Jeff began student teaching at Mt. Sterling Elementary and introduced the youth of Montgomery County to soccer. Not only did he found the boys and girls soccer programs at Montgomery County High School, but he was pivotal in setting up middle school soccer and the youth recreation soccer program in the county to grow the game. Jeff has coached numerous All-Americans, state champion contenders, and was vital in setting up the soccer coaches association. He not only was known for the game in the state of Kentucky but also marketed the teams and players of the state nationally in the National Soccer Coaches Association of America (now known as United Soccer Coaches). A search on the Lexington Herald-Leader shows Lendon was often quoted for numerous soccer-based articles.

2005 Regional Coach of the Year; US Youth Soccer Association Olympic Development Program coach; coached team in four final fours and two state championship appearances in 1989 and 1994; founding member, former president and chairman of the Kentucky High School Soccer Coaches Association; organizer of the state all-star game; coach of numerous All-American soccer players at Montgomery County; founded the Montgomery County Varsity boys and girls soccer programs; top 15 in all-time wins in KHSAA Boys Soccer.
