Not only did he found the boys and girls soccer programs at Montgomery County High School, but he was pivotal in setting up middle school soccer and the youth recreation soccer program in the county to grow the game. Jeff has coached numerous All-Americans, state champion contenders, and was vital in setting up the soccer coaches association. He not only was known for the game in the state of Kentucky but also marketed the teams and players of the state nationally in the National Soccer Coaches Association of America (now known as United Soccer Coaches). A search on the Lexington Herald-Leader shows Lendon was often quoted for numerous soccer-based articles.
