At the state high school basketball tournament in 1944 THE TWINS were deluged with attention and Lexington, and Louisville newspapers glowed over their performances. On Christmas Night in 1944 THE COOK TWINS performed between games of a basketball doubleheader at New York's Madison Square Garden before 18,000 fans and received six encores.
