## 2020-21 Riflery Rules Considerations

In support of the Guidance for Opening Up High School Athletics and Activities, the Civilian Marksmanship Program offers this document as guidance on how state associations can consider modifications to their riflery matches. The modifications outlined in this document are meant to decrease potential exposure to respiratory droplets by encouraging social distancing, limiting participation in administrative tasks to essential personnel and allowing for appropriate protective equipment.

### **Return to Competition**

- 1. <u>Riflery Rules Considerations</u>
  - Rules Briefings/meetings:
    - Participants are required to prepay for all events.
    - Athlete check-in will be held outside of the facility, and participants will not be permitted within the building until their relay is called, via text.
    - Only participants with one coach or parent will be allowed into the range
      no other spectators will be authorized to enter the building.
    - Equipment and protective clothing
      - Participants are required to wear mask within the facility until on the firing line.
      - Each firing point will be cleaned and sanitized between each relay.
    - Facilities:
      - Bleachers normally placed within the ranges have been removed, with limited chairs available to parents/guardians.

#### • Spectators:

- Awards Ceremony:
  - Awards will be mailed after completion of the competition.

August 20, 2020

- Flights will be staggered a minimum of 15 minutes to provide adequate time to allow for physical distancing.
- Access will be restricted to various areas, stages, weigh-in tanks and take off docks, etc.
- All staff working the weigh-in tubs will be wearing cloth masks/face coverings and face shields. Glovers (non-latex) and hand sanitizers will be provided to anglers and staff for handling weight-in bags.

#### • During Weigh-ins:

- Multiple flights will be added to space out the anglers into small flights and multiple weigh-in tanks will be added to ensure proper fish care ad to comply with CDC social distancing, barriers to separate anglers in line will be put into place
- 1 Team/Angler with a 1 bag of fish only. NO Teams, extra people or spectators may enter the weigh-in line area. Anglers may or may not be allowed on stage, in which case they will cross in front of stage on camera set their bag of fish in the stage container provided and officials will weigh them and hand them back off the stage for pictures and return to the lake.
- Each tournament director will use a dedicated microphone.

#### • Awards Ceremony:

 No ceremony should be held that would gather a group of people. All plaques, trophies and prize checks can be presented once lace at a time or mailed to the winners. They can be called up one at a time from their vehicles or boats.
