WEEKEND OF CHAMPIONS THIS WEEK

The 2002 State Tennis Tournaments and Track & Field Meet highlight the KHSAA's "Weekend of Champions" scheduled for this weekend on the University of Kentucky campus in Lexington. The State Tennis Tournaments are scheduled for Thursday-Saturday, May 30-June 1, at the Boone/Downing Tennis Complex. The State Track & Field Meet is scheduled for Friday and Saturday, May 31-June 1, at the Shively Track

Admission to Thursday and Friday's action of the Tennis Tournaments is free. Saturday's admission to the Tennis Tournaments will be \$5 general admission and will be good for both semifinals and finals for both boys' and girls' singles and doubles events in the main stadium. Those six and under will be admitted free.

Admission to the State Track & Field Meet will be \$5 each day. Those six and under will be admitted free of charge. Gates for fans open at 7 a.m. each day.

Parking is free of charge. Fans should park in the green lot at Commonwealth Stadium, which is within walking distance to both venues.
