ST. X SWEEPS BOYS' GOLF; RUSSELL COUNTY REPEATS IN GIRLS' ACTION

Russell County picked up its second consecutive girls' state golf championship carding a two-round 660 in the 2004 Leachman Buick & GMC / KHSAA Girls' State Golf Championship held at Bowling Green Country Club last Tuesday and Wednesday. Second place Central Hardin was 12 shots back at 672. Lexington Christian was third at 687.

Woodford County's Mallory Blackwelder was individual medalist. Blackwelder finished the tournament three-under par at 141. Krista Burton of Russell County was 10 shots back of Blackwelder at 151 and Angela DeBella of Murray was third at 154.

St. Xavier swept honors at the 2004 Leachman Buick & GMC / KHSAA Boys' State Golf Championship held last Thursday and Friday at Indian Hills Country Club in Bowling Green. St. X turned in a two-day total of 592, 16 shots ahead of second place Covington Catholic. Marshall Country and Bowling Green finished tied for third at 619.

Matt Savage of St. Xavier defeated Marshall County's Nick Newcomb in a one hole playoff for medalist honors. Both Savage and Newcomb finished with two-day totals of 138. Rick Cochran of Heath and Dustin Stovall of Allen Co.-Scottsville finished tied for third at 145.
