Teams will be honored with an opening ceremony Thursday evening at the Executive Inn Rivermont in Owensboro beginning at 6:30 p.m. (CT).

General admission tickets to the double elimination event are \$9 each per day or \$15 each for a two day pass. Children under six will be admitted free. Pets are not permitted inside Fisher Park.
