The 2009 Forcht Bank/KHSAA State Baseball Championship is scheduled for this Thursday through Saturday, June 11-13, at Applebee's Park in Lexington. Quarterfinal action is scheduled for Thursday at 11 a.m., 1:30, 6 and 8:30 p.m. Gates will open at 10 a.m. Semifinals will be Friday at 6 and 8:30 p.m. and the championship on Saturday at 7 p.m. Gates will open for the semifinals at 5 p.m. on Friday and 6 p.m. for Saturday's championship.

Tickets for the 2009 Forcht Bank/KHSAA State Baseball Championship are on sale now through the Applebee's Park box office and online at http://www.khsaa.org/baseball/state.html. Fans can save \$2 by purchasing advance general admission tickets through Wednesday at 8 each. General admission tickets on gameday will be \$10 each. Super Club tickets (lower level behind home plate) are also available at \$12 in advance and \$14 on gameday. Parking is \$3 for the event.

OWENSBORO CATHOLIC GOES THE DISTANCE FOR SOFTBALL TITLE

Owensboro Catholic held off Mercy Academy to win its fourth state championship in the 2009 KHSAA State Fast Pitch Softball Tournament. In Game 31 of the double elimination event, the Lady Aces turned back Mercy 12-2 in five innings. Mercy, the champion of the consolation bracket, forced the extra game when it defeated Owensboro Catholic 4-3.

It was the first time the KHSAA State Fast Pitch Tournament went to the decisive elimination game since Ryle won the championship in 2006 by a 5-2 score over Owensboro Catholic.
