### STATE TENNIS CHAMPIONSHIPS THIS WEEKEND

The 2010 KHSAA Boys' and Girls' State Tennis Championships are scheduled for Thursday through Saturday, May 27-29. Play gets underway Thursday morning with girls' action at the Sayre Athletic Complex in Lexington, while boys' play takes place at the Boone/Downing Tennis Complex at the University of Kentucky in Lexington. On Friday and Saturday, all matches move to the Boone/Downing Tennis Complex.

Admission is free on Thursday. General Admission will be charged on both Friday and Saturday with a price of \$6 per person, good for all day. All session armbands are available, good for both days, for \$10 per person. Children under six are admitted free. Free parking is available at the Green Lot of Commonwealth Stadium. There is a parking structure located adjacent to the Boone/Downing Tennis Complex with parking available for a fee.
