In addition, Western Kentucky University and E.A. Diddle Arena will continue to serve as host site of the event through 2015.

Last year a tournament record 43,679 fans attended the event, including a record finals crowd of 5,122 as Rockcastle County defeated DuPont Manual in overtime to win its first championship.
