PARKING

Thursday Parking

- School will be in session so there will be limited parking in the Parking Structure and on the streets surrounding the area as well
- o The Natatorium parking lot is reserved for KHSAA officials, no public parking is permitted in this area
- Free parking will be available at the back half of Green Lot A beyond Papa John's Stadium
- Fans can ride the shuttle provided by KHSAA (Jefferson Transportation, Yellow School Bus) to the Ralph Wright Natatorium
- o After 4:00 p.m. there will be parking available in the Floyd Street Garage for \$5.00
- Team buses should unload promptly on Floyd Street at the Natatorium and then proceed to the back half of Green Lot A at Papa John's Stadium to park during the meet
- o Bus drivers will be able to ride the shuttle to the Ralph Wright Natatorium
- o Bus drivers will need to enter the Natatorium at the Team Check-in Tent

Friday Parking

BYLAW 22 REMINDER

KHSAA Bylaw 22 requires a member of the faculty of the school to be present along with any student-athlete who is representing a member school

COMPETITION DATES AND SCHEDULE

The 2018 Pannell Swim Shop/KHSAA Swimming and Diving State Championships are scheduled for February 22rd, 23rd and 24th at the Ralph Wright Natatorium

A complete timetable is published on the KHSAA website, as well as all other necessary information, with links available at the end of these instructions

ADMISSION INTO VENUE

PARTICIPANTS

On Thursday, Team Check-in for competitors and coaches will begin at 10:30 a.m.

On Friday, Team Check-in for competitors and coaches will begin at 7:30 a.m.

On Saturday, Team Check-in for competitors and coaches will begin at 8:30 a.m.

It will be necessary for all coaches and team members to enter the Natatorium through the designated Team Check-in area

Coaches: Each school will receive on-deck coaching credentials for admission for use by the coaches The number of credentials will be based upon the number of swimmers entered in the meet, boys and girls combined receive two credentials for nine swimmers or less, and three credentials for ten or more swimmers These must be worn at all times

COMPLIMENTARY TICKETS/PASSES/ADMISSION POLICY

No passes other than those produced for the championships will be honored at the gate

Principal, Coach, Athletic Director, Official passes or any other type of identification will not entitle the holder to admission

Designated coaches, swimmers and divers will be admitted free of charge, all other individuals must have a ticket for admission

Designated coaches' names shall be listed at team check-in

For liability and insurance reasons, deck admission is limited to meet staff, officials, coaches and state qualified competitors and will be enforced throughout the meet

USA swim coaches, unless they are a designated KHSAA high school coach, may not be listed on a team's state meet entry as an Assistant Coach or Support Personnel and may not be on the deck at any time

Boys' and girls' competitors will be allowed in free for all events but must sit in the designated team areas when not competing

GENERAL PUBLIC/FANS/NONPARTICIPANTS-FOR ALL SESSIONS

Due to seating restrictions and capacity, saving seats is prohibited

Due to limited seating, it is suggested that those wanting to attend this session arrive early

Each person will be allowed to purchase one ticket per person in line

Children ages 10 and under are admitted free for each session

At the conclusion of each session spectators will be required to vacate the Natatorium

GENERAL PUBLIC/FANS/NONPARTICIPANTS-SESSION ONE

Tickets will go on sale at 11:30 a.m. on Thursday, February 22, and will be priced at \$10.00 for session one all day on Thursday for adults, children above 10 years of age, and students

On Thursday, fans will be given an armband that must be worn at all times and will allow for access in and out of the Natatorium during both diving preliminary sessions

The pool will be closed from 3:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m. after the boys' diving preliminaries

Fans may be readmitted at no charge for the girls' diving preliminaries beginning at 5:30 p.m. provided they are still wearing their armband

This armband is good for Thursday only

GENERAL PUBLIC/FANS/NONPARTICIPANTS-SESSION TWO

Tickets will go on sale at 9:00 a.m. on Friday, February 23, and will be priced at \$10.00 for session two for adults, children above 10 years of age, and students

There is no re-entry permitted without the purchase of another ticket

GENERAL PUBLIC/FANS/NONPARTICIPANTS-SESSION THREE

Tickets will go on sale at 3:30 p.m. on Friday, February 23, and will be priced at \$10.00 for session three for adults, children above 10 years of age, and students

There is no re-entry permitted without the purchase of another ticket

GENERAL PUBLIC/FANS/NONPARTICIPANTS-SESSION FOUR

Tickets will go on sale at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, February 24, and will be priced at \$10.00 for session four for adults, children above 10 years of age, and students

There is no re-entry permitted without the purchase of another ticket

GENERAL PUBLIC/FANS/NON/PARTICIPANTS-SESSION FIVE

Tickets will go on sale at 4:15 p.m. on Saturday, February 24, and will be priced at \$10.00 for session five for adults, children above 10 years of age, and students

There is no re-entry permitted without the purchase of another ticket

VENUE LOGISTICS AND RESTRICTIONS

SPECTATOR/PARTICIPANT SEATING

Spectators must remain in the designated red bleacher area at all times

Spectators are not permitted on deck for any reason

Wheelchair/A.D.A. Accommodations – Efforts will be made to make a reasonable accommodation for those individuals who may need wheelchair access or other needs due to disabilities, please see Darren Bilberry or Michael Barren of the KHSAA or Mike Zehnder at the Natatorium for assistance

Participants located in the designated team areas around the deck must keep all exits clear at all times Participants should remain in their designated team areas while not competing

COOLERS

Athletes will be admitted with their gym bags, and unless identified as a security concern, these bags will not normally be subject to search

Team coolers can be kept in the participant deck area, but NOT in the stands

For fans and other individuals, coolers and other things used to transport food may NOT be brought inside Please keep in mind that this is an Association ruling, and is necessary for insurance and liability reasons *T-SHIRT SALES/DISTRIBUTION (NON-KHSAA SALES)*

There will be no sale or distribution of t-shirts or any other type of athletic apparel on-site, except by approved KHSAA vendors

CONDUCT OF EVENT

HEAT SHEETS

Heat Sheets and lane assignments will be posted on the KHSAA website shortly after the seeding meeting The KHSAA will provide printed copies of heat sheets and lane assignments for coaches prior to the finals

RULES POINTS OF EMPHASIS

ENTRIES

A competitor shall be permitted to enter a maximum of four events, no more than two of which may be individual events

Once a competitor swims or dives in the preliminaries in an event it counts as an event, regardless of whether or not they make the finals in that event

State qualifiers must be from the top 16 finishers from each region

The top two (2) swimmers/divers in each event, in each of the nine (9) regional qualifying meets, and the next twenty-two (22) fastest swimmers or highest scoring divers from the state at-large (determined by times and scores established in regional meets) will qualify for the State Meet

Alternates may choose whether they want to swim or dive in any event if called upon to do so

A competitor may withdraw from a preliminary event or final, including diving, with a declared false start Notice must be given to the referee or referee's designee by the swimmer, diver, coach or other team personnel

A declared false start must be reported to the referee at a published time designated by the Meet Manager The event shall still count as an entry for the competitor, however, it does not disqualify the competitor from further competition or nullify previous performances

ADDITIONAL DIVING ENTRY RULES

Dives need to be submitted by the entry deadline (Wednesday, February 21) using the Edive email entry form The Edive email entry form may be found at the end of this document

Each contestant shall submit a signed (by the coach and contestant) written description of dives on the NFHS Diving Entry Form, which shall include the number, the position, the degree of difficulty and the order in which dives will be attempted for all levels of competition, preliminaries through finals The signed diving sheets will be submitted no later than one hour before the competition is to begin on Thursday

DIVE ORDER

There will be forty (40) divers in the preliminaries

After the first three (3) dives there will be a cut to the top thirty-two (32) divers to finish the preliminaries Preliminaries: any two voluntary dives and three optional dives

Semifinals: two voluntary and one optional

All five groups of dives must be represented in the first eight rounds

Finals: one voluntary and two optional

In championship meets more than one optional dive from the same group is not permitted through the semifinals (Rule 9, Section 4, Article 1 a., b., c., & d, P-61)

The five voluntary dives shall come from each of the five groups, with their assigned DD and have a sum total of 9.0 or less

16 PLACE SCORING will be used

TIMING/JUDGING																

A fully automatic timing system and back-up watches will be used to time each event

RELAYS

Coaches must submit their relay cards according to the schedule included in the meet packets, to the Meet Director's desk

The relay cards may include as many as eight (8) names

The four (4) swimmers who are competing in the preliminaries must be marked (the lead off swimmer shall be designated)

No names may be added or deleted after this time

Being listed on the card does not count as an event unless the competitor actually competes in the event Coaches will need to mark those competing in the finals (the lead off swimmer shall be designated) according to the time sensitive schedule

FORWARD STARTS

All forward starts will adhere to the procedures outlined in the NFHS 2017-2018 Rule Book Rule 8-1-1 and NFHS Appendix A

BACKSTROKE STARTS

All backstroke starts will adhere to the procedures outlined in the NFHS 2017-2018 Rule Book Rule 8-1-2 and NFHS Appendix A

STARTING BLOCK WEDGES

Starting block wedges will not be permitted for 2018

HEALTH AND RISK MINIMIZATION INFORMATION

ATHLETIC TRAINER

Athletic Training services will be provided for participating teams during this event by Ellis and Badenhausen Orthopedics, P.S.C.

Athletic Training Staff will be available beginning one hour prior to each session and remain available throughout the day

MEDICAL VERIFICATION

Schools are reminded that they are responsible for ensuring that the parental permission to seek medical treatment is authorized from each participant

The Principal, Athletic Director and/or the Head Coach can use a copy of KHSAA Form GE04 (the physical exam form) for this purpose, as this form contains appropriate language, and should bring that form for each athlete

VENUE SAFETY

Persons who attend KHSAA events may be injured as a result of the risks inherent in being a spectator at such events

Attendance at events is a vital family and community based activity which is encouraged

Please advise KHSAA or venue personnel of any situation you encounter which you or a competitor feels should be addressed to minimize risk to all involved

EMERGENCY ACTION PLAN

KHSAA Staff will, in consultation with the Athletic Training Staff and Venue personnel, develop an Emergency Action Plan for this event

This plan will be available upon arrival on-site from the Athletic Training Staff

STATE EVENT OFFICIALS

Officials presiding over the event are licensed and assigned by the Kentucky High School Athletic Association

SPORTSMANSHIP

The Kentucky High School Athletic Association requires officials to enforce sportsmanship rules High School Athletics emphasize positive values

All parties have worked hard to create a sense of teamwork, respect, responsibility and perspective

We remind you that officials expect good behavior and will quickly penalize misconduct

We encourage and appreciate your help

Let this competition reflect mutual respect among all participants and officials

MEDIA CREDENTIALS

SCHOOL MEDIA

Each school is permitted one (1) school media pass at KHSAA State Championship events, valid only for a full-time staff member or a student for the sole purpose of reporting the events and for taking non-commercial pictures for yearbooks, school publications, etc.

Outside entities such as professional photographers, videographers or parents may not utilize the school media pass

This pass must be requested in advance of the start of the event through the online system

TRADITIONAL MEDIA

Traditional media members (print, TV, radio, online) interested in covering KHSAA State Championship events should apply for credentials through the KHSAA's online system

Applications should be submitted by the editor or director at each organization

Freelance photographers will not be granted access to KHSAA events unless the requisite media rights fee is paid

MEDIA RIGHTS FEE

Freelance/commercial photographers and radio stations interested in originating a broadcast of a KHSAA State Championship event, are subject to a media rights fee

Information regarding the media rights fee for each event is available through the online credentialing system TEAM BROADCASTS

By paying the requisite fee, each school qualifying for a KHSAA State Championship event may designate one (1) radio station or website to originate an AUDIO-only broadcast of each game its affiliated school participates in

An official representative of the participating school shall designate to the KHSAA which station/website will be permitted to broadcast its game using the online system

The radio station/website shall then apply for championship credentials through the KHSAA's online credentialing system

Originating stations/websites will be subject to a media rights fee, which will be outlined through the online credentialing system

The KHSAA is the only entity permitted to originate or authorize a video broadcast of KHSAA State Championship events

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

The intellectual property, corporate, broadcasting and media rights to the postseason rounds prior to the state finals belong exclusively to the KHSAA, including titling agreements and sponsorships

BROADCAST/TELECAST/WEBCAST RIGHTS

No member school can sign an exclusive agreement for a postseason round (district, region, sub-section, section) without agreement between the schools and approval of the KHSAA Office including full compliance with the restrictions of the NFHS Network and the KHSAA participation in the network

At all levels of competition during postseason play, control of media access and location at those contests is with the KHSAA

In general, the management of those rights may be assigned to the manager at the host KHSAA member school for the district, regional and sectional (semi-state) competition

At all levels of competition, including district, regional, sectional, and state competition in KHSAA sponsored tournaments and meets, managers are encouraged to make allowances for members of the television media to tape the contests at no charge to the media outlet, as long as the taping is for the sole purpose of newscast highlights

CHAMPIONSHIP PHOTOS

The KHSAA pays for professional photography coverage of the event

Official championship photos of the event will be available for purchase through the KHSAA's online photo gallery within 72 hours of the completion of the event

Coaches/Parents WILL NOT be permitted to access the deck to take pictures during the meet or the awards ceremonies

VIDEOTAPING

External power sources may not be used by patrons

Patrons may videotape any portion of this competition from the confines of their defined spectator area but may not in any manner transmit video live through any resource, including personal social media accounts Violators are subject to removal

Credentials will be required for those wishing to videotape diving sessions for All-American consideration Anyone wishing to access the deck during these sessions will be required to go to the team check-in media entrance on Thursday and Saturday to request their credentials after purchasing their ticket

There will be a different color credential each day and this credential will allow these individuals on deck only during the diving sessions of the meet

Coaches please share this information with anyone who plans on filming and email that person's name to Darren Bilberry at your earliest convenience

Filming will occur next to the judges

Due to limited space there will be a waiting area on deck and then an area to film which they will access when your athlete is ready to dive

NFHS NETWORK INFORMATION AND WEBSTREAMING

No web streaming may be approved for any outlet without the payment of the requisite fee as mandated by the KHSAA/NFHS Network agreement, with the sole exception of a waiver for those schools participating in the School Broadcast Program of the NFHS Network

The fee schedule will be published annually by the Commissioner's office and is available by contacting the Communications Director

EVENT MERCHANDISING

KHSAA State Championship apparel will be available for sale at the event and online post event

TeamIP is the exclusive vendor of championship apparel, please look for their tent at the championship event to purchase memorabilia

No outside merchandise representative of the event may be produced by any other entity and sold or distributed inside the playing facility

POST EVENT

RESULTS

Results will be posted at the competition and later on the KHSAA website

TROPHIES AND AWARDS

Medals will be given for the top eight places in each event

A team trophy will be given to the winning, runner-up, third and fourth place boys' and girls' teams

There will also be a combined team first and second place trophy awarded along with various individual awards

- Only properly credentialed media members are permitted to take pictures during the awards ceremony
- Coaches are not permitted to use cameras or camera phones to take pictures from the deck during the meet or the awards presentation
- The KHSAA has an official event photographer taking professional photos that will be available for purchase on the KHSAA website following the event

Participation in the awards ceremony is NOT optional and is an expectation for entering the event PANNELL SWIM SHOP SCHOLARSHIP

Pannell Swim Shop will be giving a 500.00 scholarship to one male and one female participant *MIDWAY AWARD*

Coaches have previously nominated candidates for this sport/sport-activity for the Midway Female Student-Athlete of the Year

KHSAA staff will make every effort to contact the coach and/or parents of the winner to have them present for this award

NFHS COACH OF THE YEAR

The National Federation of High Schools' Coaches Association recognize the Coach of the Year Award in each of the sports sanctioned by the KHSAA

The KHSAA staff will make every effort to contact the coach to have them present for this award FINANCES AND EXPENSES
